Skipper	You must possess a Sportseeschifferschein (SSS) or an equivalent license (such as the RYA Yachtmaster Offshore). Several years of experience would be an advantage. You must remain calm in demanding situations and be fair and considerate when dealing with inexperienced crew members. Please send us a scan of your license.	Yes
Co-skipper	You must possess a Sportküstenschifferschein (SKS) or an equivalent license (such as RYA Coastal Yachtmaster). You relieve the skipper when asked to and take over their duties if they are impeded.	Yes
Navigator	You must independently lead a watch, including in the dark. You must have sailing experience, be able to navigate, know the collision prevention rules, and feel confident performing simple maneuvers.	Yes
Technician	You have experience with the maintenance and repair of electrical and/or mechanical systems of boats/ships.	Yes
Doctor, paramedic	You have medical training and previous experience with rotations under unfavorable conditions. Please send us a scan of relevant certificates. Important: Please fill out the attached skill assessment form.	Yes
Communication coordinator	You are responsible for the communications between the ship crew and the land crew and support with communications with authorities. You must speak fluent German and English and have computer skills.	Yes
Deckhand	You help onboard the ship where help is needed. You must be seaworthy and work well in teams.	Yes

Please note the following information about COVID-19 and our hygiene concept:

To reduce the risk of COVID-19 infection during a rotation to a minimum and thereby protect the health of our crewmates, we have developed a hygiene concept that is based above all else on regular testing.

Due to the dynamic status, we cannot fully guarantee that crewmates will not be placed under quarantine after returning to Sicily or your country of residence by the relevant authorities. Such measures can extend the length of a rotation. Whether a quarantine is ordered depends significantly on what happens during the rotation (ex. contact with people outside of the crew) as well as development of the incidence of COVID-19 in Sicily.

Please keep this in mind while planning and assessing your availability and stay up-to-date on your country's quarantine policy.

Questions for paramedics

The following questions are meant to give us an idea of your emergency and first aid skills. An accurate assessment is very important and allows us to assemble a crew with sufficient emergency medical expertise. Lack of experience does not mean exclusion from a rotation! Please shortly describe your skill level und, where appropriate, where you gained your skills.

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How experienced are you in measuring and assessing vital functions? Example of an answer: "Very confident, several years of work experience in an emergency room."
Do you have experience securing/maintaining vital functions? Ex. airways, resuscitation, fluid delivery, emergency medication, etc.
How confident are you at performing a resuscitation? (cardiac massage, AED)
Do you have experience dressing wounds? (open wounds, burns, etc.)
How confident are you at inserting an intravenous line?
How confident are you at treating children?
How confident do you feel in handling psychological emergencies?
